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3. PLOT: Every story has ongoing events, plus actions by characters. A writer usually starts a story by introducing characters and problems that they face. The sequence of main actions (in the present, past, future) by characters, as they respond to and solve problems through time, is called the plot.

4. THEME/MAIN IDEA/MEANING: A main idea may be a big situation facing the characters (such as a war, or a journey to discover new land), and how they reacted. Or, a main idea can be a lesson learned in reading the story. Sometimes a single sentence tells the story's main lesson. Examples: In the story of the Three Little Pigs, the lesson is that those who prepare carefully will be safe through all kinds of dangers. Another way to tell the lesson is: when a person only plays and wastes time, someday he will be very sorry for not preparing wisely for the future.
